Career Partnership Program

Hooray for Summer Employment Days!

In April, The Career Partnership Program will invite several local youth employers to Guidance to meet with groups of students regarding summer employment. This is a great opportunity to bring together both students seeking employment and employers seeking employees. Students can, during their lunchtime here at school, access the employers. Employers will bring applications and information regarding job expectations, for example, many employers require students to be available weekends in the summer. In a roundtable format, employers give students a taste of a real job interview. We ask that students arrive prepared, dressed well and ready to discuss their skills, i.e. good at math for working a cash register, good with people for working with customers, etc.

We encourage parents to actively participate in their child's employment and discuss all potential jobs with their student and with a potential supervisor/business owner. Students participating in Summer Employment Days are not guaranteed a job and may be required to participate in additional interviews. Students can sign up in guidance to meet with individual businesses. A list of participating businesses will be posted soon on the Career Partnership tab of the guidance department webpage.

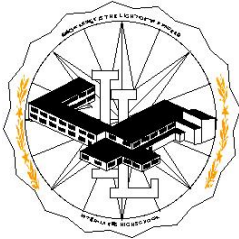
