<b><u>Cohort Group Comparisons</u></b>											
Year to year comparisons should not be made due to the extremely small sample size. Cohort group (students who took the test in 3rd grade and then again in 6th grade) comparisons are slightly more meaningful, but must be viewed carefully due to the fact that there are always a few new students each year and a few students who move away.
