



## Scholarships & Free Applications Available to NH Scholars for 2022-2023

Institutions are providing merit-based scholarships to students who are on track to graduate with the distinction of a NH Scholar.

**Colby-Sawyer College:** Offers renewable merit scholarships ranging up to **\$8,000** a year. NH Scholars students may be eligible. Apply for admission online for free at <a href="www.commonapp.org">www.commonapp.org</a>. There is no fee to apply

Franklin Pierce University: Annually renewable merit scholarships ranging from \$22,000 to \$33,000 for accepted NH Scholars, STEM or ARTS students. Students majoring in Biology or Health Sciences may be eligible for an additional \$3,500 Health Sciences Scholarship. Students are considered for merit scholarships at the time of application review and no additional application is required. Notification of awards is included in your acceptance letter. Additionally, NH Scholars with a minimum 3.0 grade point average and adjusted family income below \$60,000 will attend Franklin Pierce tuition free. There is no fee to apply for admission at Franklin Pierce using the Common Application at www.commonapp.org or directly at www.franklinpierce.edu.

**Keene State College:** Offers NH Scholars graduates who meet the merit scholarship requirements, renewable awards of \$1,000 - \$6,000 annually. Students are considered for merit scholarships at the time of application review and no additional application is required. Notification of awards is included in your acceptance letter. MA College of Pharmacy & Health Sciences: Massachusetts College of Pharmacy and Health Sciences: Offers renewable scholarships ranging from \$8,000 to \$18,000 per year. Scholarships are awarded at the time of admission; no separate scholarship application is required. Apply for admission online at www.commonapp.org. There is no fee to apply.

**New England College:** Offers NH Scholars renewable merit scholarships up to \$32,000 for for accepted NH Scholars and up to \$51,000 annually for nurses pursuing a 12-month schedule. For NH STEM or ART Scholars, accepted students qualify for a renewable merit awards, up to four years for traditional students and three years for the 32-month nurse candidates. or www.commonapp.org . There is no fee to apply and application automatically submits students for merit scholarships.

**Institute of Art & Design at New England College:** Candidates for the NH Scholars ARTS Pathway will be offered renewable merit scholarships up to \$32,000 annually upon acceptance into the BFA program. For a fee waiver, please email Dr. Karen M. Scolforo at KScolforo@nec.edu prior to applying.

**Plymouth State University** offers NH Scholars renewable merit scholarships ranging from \$2,000 - \$7,000. Additionally, students accepted into a STEM field at PSU are eligible for an additional \$1,000 STEM award. Merit-awards and STEM scholarships are renewable for four years, bringing the total value of awards for NH Scholars to \$12,000 to \$32,000. Apply for admission online for free via the Common Application with Fee Waiver Code NHSCHOLAR or at www.plymouth.edu/apply via the Panther Application.

Rivier University: Offers NH Scholars renewable merit scholarships up to \$20,000 for accepted NH Scholars. Additionally students within the Greater Nashua area are encouraged to apply for the Tamposi Scholarship which awards four renewable scholarships yearly ranging from \$2,500 - \$5,000. **Saint Anselm College:** Offers renewable merit scholarships ranging from \$16,000 - \$30,000. NH Scholars students may be eligible. Students applying may waive the application fee by using the fee waiver code "NH603" when submitting the Common Application or Saint Anselm College application.

**Southern New Hampshire University:** Apply for admission online for free <a href="https://www.snhu.edu/admission/campus-admission">https://www.snhu.edu/admission/campus-admission</a>.

**University of New Hampshire:** Offers qualified NH Scholars graduates who meet institutional merit scholarship and admission requirements, renewable merit scholarships valued at \$1,000-\$9,000 per year. Students are considered for merit scholarships at the time of application review for admission; no additional scholarship application is required. Notification of eligibility is shared in a student's letter of acceptance to UNH. Each **New Hampshire Community College:** Offers NH Scholars twelve (12) **\$500** merit awards to accepted NH Scholars (guidance should communicate with local admission director to determine how many are available). Awards are not renewable.

## **Recognizing New Hampshire Scholars:**

After confirming eligibility with their school counselor, students are encouraged to identify themselves as New Hampshire Scholars during the fall of their senior year. Students should also highlight the NH Scholars achievement on their college applications and follow up with the college admissions office to ensure colleges are aware of this honor. Additionally, high schools are encouraged to add NH Scholars to a student's transcript. All New Hampshire institutions receive the full roster of NH Scholars students in early spring of their senior year.
